Directions: Turn west onto Pearl Lake Rd from Dearborn. Front office is at end of Pearl Lake Rd. Scuba sites are accessed via service road heading north just before front office. Follow service road to end (through gate in fence) at north side of lake. East and west dive site accessible via service road from there.

Site-Specific Procedures:

- Dial 911 to call Emergency Medical Services (EMS). Tell the dispatcher you are at **Pearl Lake Beach in South Beloit, IL and in the diving area**, give **your name and group** if applicable, the **nature of the emergency** and **what dive site that you are located at**. (**NOTE:** In regards to **night dives on Saturday evenings**, a **member of the group MUST meet the EMS at the main gate to guide them to the dive site/victim's location!**)
- If possible, to attempt to speed the response, **please call the Pearl Lake office**, and **advise them of your emergency** and **what dive site you are at** on the lake so they can attempt to assist the EMS in locating you.
- **Any scuba diving accident/incident must be reported to the main office manager immediately** and a copy of the **Divestore's/Diving Professional's Liability Insurance carrier's Accident/Incident Report Form** must be completed and submitted to Pearl Beach LLC within 24 hour of the occurrence.
